### The Organisation

### About the Position

We are looking for an economics and public policy specialist. S/he will provide in-depth technical support in the area of financial analysis, behavioural economics and public policy including but not limited to recommending policy reforms, drafting regulations, suggesting changes in existing laws, developing institutional frameworks as well as collection and analysis of data.

The position is based out of work from home, but the candidate may need to travel to other project cities as and when required. S/he will report to the Senior Programme Manager. S/he will work closely with ITDP India Programme's city teams, head office staff, and international experts.

### Roles and responsibilities

- Work with the ITDP India team to conduct economic modelling, cost-benefit analysis, financial analysis, and behavioural economics studies of sustainable mobility solutions across the city.
- Analyse existing policies, regulations and laws. Conduct gap assessment studies and recommend reforms. Create policy briefs and suggest institutional frameworks for implementing the same.
- Develop indicators for monitoring and evaluation framework to measure the effectiveness of reforms.
- Gather information on international best practices in economics and policy of mobility planning.

- Work with governments and public transport authorities to structure surveys, as well as collect, process and analyze data.
- Prepare high-quality technical reports with recommendations.
- Conduct capacity building programmes for different government agencies.
- Work with the Communications team to create communications materials that facilitate implementation of ITDP initiatives.

## Qualification & Experience

- A master's degree in economics/ public policy with training in data and statistics with five years of relevant professional experience.
- Familiarity with survey design, economic modelling, and policy analysis.
- Excellent spreadsheet skills are required. Experience with Stata/ SPSS/ Python/ R-language or any other similar data analysis software is desirable.
- Prior experience in impact analysis, including social, environmental, and economic impact.
